Safe Harbor

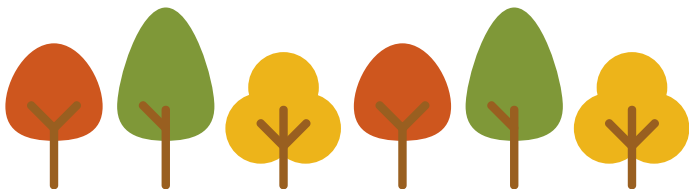
Program: Youth Services

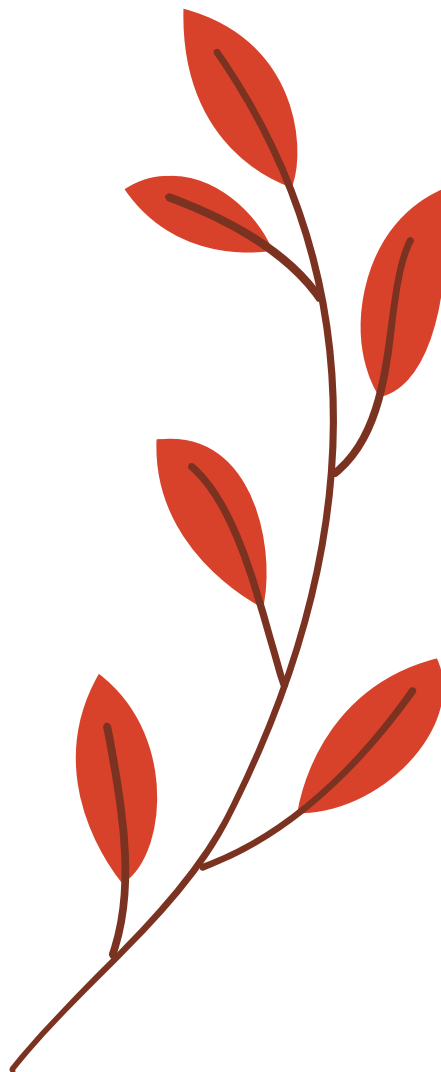
