Renters Eviction Assistance Project (REAP) Presentation

Legal action of Wisconsin runs a program out of Milwaukee that provides pro bono legal assistance to people with eviction cases. ML Donohue worked to replicate that program in Sheboygan County, working with corporate lawyers to provide services. REAP has been serving clients in Sheboygan County since August 20, 2021.

Lakeshore CAP is the key partner in referring individuals to REAP. There is a REAP pre-screen on the Lakeshore CAP website (lakeshorecap.org). After completing that pre-screen, individuals are referred to the program.

The project has served 49 individuals since August.
