**Investments include** 40 Partner Agency programs facilitated by 24 different agencies, UWSC's three Community Impact Initiatives (Community Partnership for Children, Providing Access To Healing, and the Volunteer Center), along with other services such as 2-1-1 Resource Center, 2022 Day of Caring Grants, support for Diversity Equity Inclusion and Belonging for the social sector, Emergency Reserve Grant, and a new After Hours program, among other investments.
