## LOCAL COMMUNITY NEEDS

### YOUTH MENTAL HEALTH

- Approximately 3,245 Sheboygan County children struggle with a mental health disorder
- Estimated 250 students are on a waitlist to receive therapy through PATH



### EARLY CARE & EDUCATION

- 3,230 children potentially without childcare
- 340 children are on waiting lists for childcare in the county
- Average cost of childcare is \$1,124 per month



### ESSENTIAL NEEDS

- 30% of Sheboygan County residents struggle to pay for basic needs
- 1 in 3 children in Sheboygan County public school districts participate in free and reduced lunch
